EXPLANATIONS

It looks as though I must have been miss-spelling the name of the president of China, who became head of the Chinese Communist Party after the "Tiananmen Square Massacre" - I have been spelling his name Ziang Zemin. But it seems the correct spelling is Jiang Zemin. (Or his name may have two spellings, like Mao's Mao Tse-tung (and Mao Zedong, I believe). The second spelling for Mao is more like the pronunciation given for the first spelling in my dictionary. It must be hard (a lot of times) to find the equivalent English SPELLING to match the Chinese PRONUNCIATION of names.

MORE ABOUT MONTANA

Have you seen the January 2002 Reader's Digest? Perhaps you could understand me and my ways a little better if you would read the short, true, "Turning Point" story by a young woman in her mid-twenties, "A Montana State of Mind". One thing she and I have in common is our casual way of dressing. Another is a love for nature. She met her husband in Livingston, the Park county seat, 20 miles from little Clyde Park where I was born (no connection to the county name, as far as I know), where I spent my first four and a half years, and where my brother Russ and I visited when we were both in Montana for our family reunion in the summer of 1999.

Later Maggie Kim and her family "moved to a ranch at the foot of the Crazy Mountains," she says. I remember the mountain range I looked up to as a child as the "Crazy Mountains" (Don't know the story behind that name.)

I wanted SO bad to go to Montana this summer! When it did not work out, I was extremely disappointed.

But Montana came to ME, in this article. Also in another way, early in the fall. One Sunday a friend and I visited Friendship Missionary Baptist Church for the evening service. A visitor (who referred to her airplane flight from the west) expressed gratitude for her blessings. I decided to share an experience from a Sunday school class I had been in as a child in Montana, where our teacher also had us sing "John 3:16" in place of the words in the song's chorus, just as the preacher's wife had done at Friendship Church.

When I mentioned Montana, the visiting lady said: "I'm from Montana!" Afterward, as I talked with her and her daughter, who has been working in the east, I learned that the mother lives on the Flathead Reservation in western Montana. I asked them: "Have you ever heard of Browning, on the Blackfeet Reservation?" "I was BORN there!" the daughter answered. They lived at Browning since I was there 50 years ago, so I asked about one person whose name came back to me, Earl Old Person. (I remember him as one of the young men on the high school basketball team who wore long braids.) They gave me an interesting update on Earl.

Also, back in 2000 I had a surprising experience at Shoney's Restaurant in Lumberton. In the ladies' room I happened to make a comment about being from Montana. The mother I was talking to surprised me by remarking about her young daughter: "Her GRANDMA is from Montana!" I ended up joining this family to eat lunch. It turned out that the HUSBAND'S grandma had actually grown up in Clyde Park! He said his mother was living in South Carolina, and gave me her phone number.

SO many "small world" experiences when you've lived as long as I have! And to think that I can just STAY here on the east coast and have MONTANA come to me!
