into the gulph of Florida much about the place where the current ce.fes to have any effect; Big Savannah about 24 miles weftward of Apalachee; Little Savannah about 100 miles fouthweft of Apalachee; Calafabatchee about 100 miles to the fouthward of Little Savannah; the three rivers laft named running into the gulph of Mexico.

The principal harbours yet difcovered are, St. Mary's, St. Fobn's, St. Augufine, Maganzas, Musticoes, Honda, Key-Weft, Tamper and Apalachee, of which no particular defcciptions can be given, as they have not yet been furveyed and founded.
