

into the gulph of Florida much about the place where the current ceases to have any effect; *Big Savannah* about 24 miles westward of *Apalachee*; *Little Savannah* about 100 miles southwest of *Apalachee*; *Calasahatchee* about 100 miles to the southward of *Little Savannah*; the three rivers last named running into the gulph of Mexico.

The principal harbours yet discovered are, *St. Mary's*, *St. John's*, *St. Augustine*, *Maganzas*, *Muskicoes*, *Honda*, *Key-West*, *Tamper* and *Apalachee*, of which no particular descriptions can be given, as they have not yet been surveyed and founded.

Given under my hand, and the great seal of his Majesty's said province, this thirty first day of October, in the year of our Lord 1764, and in the fifth year of his Majesty's reign.

**N**O T I C E is hereby given to all Masters of Vessels, That by the late Act to prevent the Exportation of unmerchantable Commodities, they are not to ship or take on board their Vessels, any Pork, Beef, Pitch, Tar, Turpentine, Rice, Tanned Leather, Deer-Skins, &c. before such Commodities have been inspected, and shall have the Inspector's Brand or Stamp thereon, under the Penalty of *One Hundred Pounds*.—And further, that no Collector presume to clear out any Ship or Vessel, before the Master or Commander thereof shall produce to such Collector, a Certificate from under the Hand of the Inspector or Inspectors, of his Cargo's being inspected according to Law, under the Penalty of *Fifty Pounds*.—And also, That if any Master of a Vessel shall take on board any uninspected Commodity, his Vessel is liable to be searched, and such Commodities forfeited.

The Inspector of the Town of *Newbern*, gives the above Notice, that all Persons concerned may demean themselves accordingly, and prevent the Penalties by Law inflicted.
