but the legiflative one of this country can accomplifh. Hitherto my endeavours bave proved either abortive, or of little effect : but laft autumn having heard that the miniftry had formed a plan of revenue to be raifed in America, fufficient to defray Great-Britain's expence for that country, which was to be laid before parliament the enfuing feffion, and in which, among other things, I could give no account of; there was a ftamp duty, and one of 4 d . per gallon on foreign molaffes: I judged it a proper time to renew my application for the adoption of a plan I had drawn up feveral years ago, and is now intended to be printed, with obfervations on the late act, and to be fent to you. Accordingly I waited on the fecretaries of ftate, to whom I had the honour of being known, and exhibitted it to them: it was fent by one of them to the chancellor of ' the exchequer, with whom I had not the leaft aequaintance, and by the fender I was afterwards introduced to him. Several conferences with this minifter enfued, in which I endeavoured, tho' ineffectually, to prevail on him to poftpone the ftamp duty until the opinion of the colonies upon the fubject might be known: nor could I obtain his confent to the reduction of the duty on molaffes to lower than 3 d. per Gallon. This was all I knew of the intention of government, previous to the introduction of the plan into the houfe of commons.

LONDDON.

The following naval Expeditions are now faid to be refolved on: A commodore, with three fhips of the line, and two frigates, for the coaft of Guiney: An admiral, with five fail of the line, and three frigates, for Newfoupdland: An admiral, with fix line of battle fhips, for the Eaft. Indies, to touch at the Spanifh Philippines : A commodore in the Me. diterranean, and another to reinforce the fleet on the Wefl-India flation.
A correfpondent at Amflerdam writes, that there were no lefs than feven fhips of war upon the flocks at that place, viz. two of 70 guns, one of 60 , two of 50 , and two of 40 . At Rotterdam, one of 64 , and two of 36 guns. And at Middleborough in Zealand, three of different frengths. At Amfterdam, they were alfo bufy in thipping 350 pieces of ordnance for France, befides near 1000 tons of cordage.
It is now faid, that our naval frength in the Weft Indies, is to be augmented with all expedition by $15^{\circ}$ (hips of the line, to be manned chiclly with turn overs from other fhips, daily paying off at Portfmouth, Plymouth and Chatham.

The Snow Dorothy, Capt. Graham, who loaded here lately for Europe, and had been failed about 19 Days, is afhore at Core-Sound; chief of the Cargo will be faved.
