because there are more teachers to appoint. Special care should be taken in the selection of the type of persons to serve on the special committee to work with the board of education of the county. While there are many members of the race in Durham who have the educational qualifications, all of them do not have other requirements that are necessary to make them fit for service on such an important committee. The assistance of the Committee on Negro Affairs would do much to aid in the selection of the three Negroes to

be appointed. This committee while possibly not the very best does have the backing of a majority of the race, and it is possibly more in position to give information on the type of persons best fitted for the Negro Advisory Board.

dimes, but according to its true value. The lawyer who takes advantage of his professional position to rob the poor people of their miserable pennies is as guilt-worthy as a minister who disobeys his calling. Herein lies the superlative opportunity of the educated Negro of the present day and generation.

He should qualify himself by taking advantage of the deepest and highest educational privileges that college and culture afford, and should consecrate himself in the spirit of self-sacrifice to serve his race without stint or limit in the high places of intellectual, social, moral and spiritual leadership. Herein lies the wide-open door of hope to the youth of the present generation, but if they persist in the quest of greed, glamour and glory of the white world they will bring down upon their own heads, and that of the race, self-execution of all the woes and calamities which the Hebrew prophet foretold would befall the children of Abraham.

If the 2,000 Negro graduates who take their degrees in June, and the college generations which are to follow them, will embrace their task in this spirit, they will save their race from the impending wrath which may not otherwise be averted. Kelly Miller.
