The equalization fund will consist of \$100,00 of state money, which will be matched by \$100.000 by the federal government. It is designed to aid those counties which would have to levy an excessive tax rate in order to raise their one-fourth contribution for indigent aged and one-third for dependent children.

Yelton explained that the only counties eligible were those in which the combined levy for the two programs wipld exceed 1) that the equalization fund would contribute 75 per cent on the difference.
