MOB TARS LABOR MAN IN TEXAS

WHO SHOWS NEGRO, WHITE WOMEN IN PICKET LINE

DALLAS, Tex., Aug. 17—(AP) Soon after he had shown a labor film Monday night in which colored and white women marched together in a picket line, Herbert Harris, 47, white Socialist party organizer, was kidnapped by a group of hoodlums who raided the labor meeting, oiled and feathered and dumped from an auto on a main st.

"Get back up North," shouted the abductors. There were about 20 men in the mob that invaded the park where the meeting was in progress. They overturned Harris' auto, which carried a projection machine. The audience of 200 scattered as the organizer was rushed into an auto and taken into the country where his outer garments were torn off and crude oil and feathers splashed over him.

Harris was uninjured and after being returned here, joked and talked with newsmen about the kidnapping as he posed for pictures.

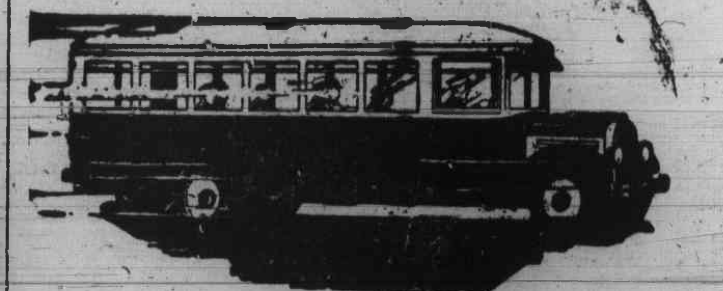
