Aged Wilson Woman Victim Unavoidable Traffic Accident

WILSON, (Special to THE TIMES) — Mrs. Hattie Evans who was 57 years old died Monday evening at a local hospital here where she was taken immediately after being struck by a truck earlier in the day. The truck driver was W. P. Barnes. Although Police and witnesses said that the accident was absolutely unavoidable Mr. Barnes expressed sincere concern and regret at having been the driver of the truck responsible for Mrs. Evans' death and said that he would be willing to do anything in all his power to try to make up in some small way for the unhappiness and heart ache that the tragedy had caused the family of Mrs. Evans. Mr. Barnes further stated that one of his greatest desires had been to have always a record for safe driving and to think that this had happened to him would be a blow that he would not soon get over.

The accident occurred just as he was turning out of Douglas Street into Nash going east, and at a very slow rate of speed at that. According to Mr. Barnes statement Mrs. Evans stepped out directly in front of the car to cross the street to the point on the otherside where her husband was waiting and witnessed the whole thing.

Although accidents of this sort are greatly to be regretted it is worth while to note that there are people to be found who are sympathetic and concerned enough even though victim is of another race, to want to try to make up in some small way for the unhappiness that these unexpected and unwanted accidents cause another fellow being.
