

Negroes To Have Major Role In NEA Convention

Washington — Several leaders in Negro education will carry participating roles in committee, commission and sectional deliberations of the National Education Association's 88th annual convention at St. Louis, June 30-July 7.

Severing as committeemen, consultants and reporters during the eight-day confab will be six persons who work in various areas of education for Negro boys and girls. More than 3,500 leaders in education will assemble in Saint Louis for the eight-day confab.

Heading the list of Negro participants will be Dr. George W. Gore, Jr., president of the American Teachers Association and recently elected president of Florida A. and M. College, Tallahassee. Dr. Gore will serve as a consultant and convention reporter for an information session on "Education Abroad." Many foreign educators will participate in this sectional conference.

Dr. J. Rupert Picott, executive secretary of the Virginia Teachers Association, Richmond, is listed as a resource person and consultant for a group which will give attention to programs and activities concerning "Steps That Can Be Taken To Make The NEA Program And Structure More Effective."

HAIL NEW CURE



A medical research team made up of physicians from the District of Columbia Health Department and the Federal Security Agency have reported a new 1-day cure for gonorrhea. The physicians found that two one-half gram doses of Terramycin taken at 6-hour intervals were sufficient to produce a one hundred per cent cure of the disease.

Terramycin is a new earth-cord drug discovered after screening 100,000 samples of soil from all over the world. The mold which produces Terramycin is recovered from a fermentation process (shown above). Public health and medical authorities believe that with the discovery of the effectiveness of antibiotics against syphilis and gonorrhea it is now medically possible to eradicate venereal disease in the United States within a single year's time.

According to Dr. Morris, units of the congress include the Sunday School, Allen Christian Endeavor League, the Young People's Department of Missionary Society, the Richard Allen Youth Council, Boy and Girl Scouts, the Junior Church, and the Layman's League. Plans have been completed for a Leader's Workshop and Seminars for ministers and lay leaders.

The congress, having as its theme, "They will be done through me," will feature the Centennial Biennial Oratorical Contest and a pageant which will depict the rise and development of the A. M. E. Church, staged in the 12,000 capacity stadium on Morris Brown Col-

lege campus. The oratorical contest is to be open to youths belonging to the A. M. E. Church and scholarships will go to the winners.

The Richard Allen Youth Council is slated to interpret such topics as Christian Youth Preparing for World Order, and Christian Youth and Interracial Understanding.

Papacy Establishes Dioceses In Africa; Africans To Head

Rome — After 1,400 years of exile and hopeful waiting, the Catholic Church officially returned in full episcopal vigor this week to the mysterious and gigantic "dark continent" of Africa.

Pope Pius XII created three archdioceses and 11 dioceses, and announced that as soon as possible, all will be under exclusive control of native Negro bishops and archbishops. The areas involved — once

apparently lost forever to the Church — today have a Catholic population of approximately 1,000,000, and have at least 360,000 catechumens awaiting baptism.
