



A medical research team made up of physicians from the District of Columbia Health Department and the Federal Security Agency have reported a new 1-day cure for gonorrhea. The physicians found that two one-half gram doses of Terramycin taken at 6-hour intervals were sufficient to produce a one hundred per cent cure of the disease.

Terramycin is a new earth-mold drug discovered after screening 100,090 samples of soil from all over the world. The mold which produces Terramycin is recovered from a fermentation process (shown above). Public health and medical authorities believe that with the discovery of the effectiveness of antibiotics against syphilis and ganorrhea it is now medically possible to eradicate venereal disease in the United States within a single wars spent by the group.




