



cup brown sugar cups soft enriched yeast-raised bread crumbs cups chopped suet boil. Turn down neat but keep water boiling from four to six hours, the longer the better. If necessary, add more boiling water to keep water at original halfway level. level. When done remove mold from water and turn out on cake rack to cool. Pudding can be made two weeks before Christmas, cooled then wrapped in alum-inum foil until Christmas day. It may be served cold surrounded with hard sauce pressed through a pastry tube or hot with a lemon sauce. Put all ingredients into a very large bowl and mix until well blended. Pack into two well-greased pudding molds or two coffee cans leaving about 1/4 inch

sauce. Reheat pudding by steaming it in the mold as you did in the beginning — about 2 hours. space at the top for expansion
