maintenance of all-purpose Student Health Services Building, the allocation of other special facilities for Student Government, student publications, and the campus-wide emphasis upfacilities to promote the philo-sophy of guided self-direction— all assure the NCC student of opportunities for virtually unlimited experimentation in liv-ing in the modern manner. The college's president is now busy at work supervising planning and construction of three new buildings for biology, commerce and education.
