Mission to Liberia, is sure to be the next Ambassador to the West African republic. State Department sources predict an early appointment—possibly within six weeks—to fill the post left vacant by the death of Ambassador Jesse D. Locker, at Monrovia, on April 10. Others, on the policy-making level, point out that the only quick means of filling the vacancy would be the appointment of someone already cleared and on location, and further that FOA, in which Jones now works, will become a part of the State Department, and so responsible to the Ambassador, in a matter of weeks. An Ambassador who has already learned the foreign side ropes could be a distinct asset. Also Jones is already "acceptable" to the Liberian Government. Won't need to do much but hold up his right hand.
