NOTICE OF THE EXTENSION OF PRECINCT BOUNDARY LINES TO INCLUDE AREAS PRESENTLY ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF DURHAM, AND

HE POLLING PLACES THEREFOR AS ESTABLISHED.

Whereas, the City of Durham has in the recent past extended the corporation limits of the City of Durham to include additional areas, and in order to have precincts conform to the extended city boundaries, it has been duly enacted by the Board of Elections that each of the following specified areas shall be attached to and become a part of the precinct indicated:

HILLSIDE PARK HIGH SCHOOL PRECINCT:
That the area between the southern boundary line and the newly established limits east of South Street and west of Otis Street shall become a part of the Hillside Park High School Precinct. The polling place will be at Whitted School as now established.

FOREST HILLS PRECINCT:
That portion of the new city limits lying south of the old city limits, beginning at Arrington Street and Cole Road, and extending southwardly to the new city limits including all the area within the Arnoldo Development, with the area attached thereto, lying east and west of Stuart Drive and south of Woodridge Drive; becoming a part of the Forest Hills Precinct and the polling place will be the Forest Hills Club House as now established.

WEST DURHAM SOUTH SIDE SCHOOL:
All of the following described area to become a part of the West Durham South Side Precinct, to-wit: west of the old city limits between the Southern Railroad on the north, and 751 on the south and west, and extending beyond 751 to the new city limits, being known as the Poplar Apartments area. The polling place will be West Durham South Side School as now established.

CLUB BOULEVARD PRECINCT:
All that area north and west of the old city limits being bounded by Hillsboro Road, Central Farm Road, Indian Trail Road and Albany Street, known as the Hillandale Golf Course Development; becoming a part of Club Boulevard Precinct. The polling place will be Hillandale Club House on Club Boulevard as now established.

WATTS STREET SCHOOL PRECINCT:
All that area north of the old city limits and south of the city limits lying south of Ellerbee Creek; west of Maryland Ave-

ue extending to a line east of Forest Road as now established; becoming a part of Watts Street School Precinct. The polling place will be Watts Street School as now established.
