But when his church is one which requires blind obedience to her, in preference to any and every other consideration, and he feels that it is his solemn obligation to advance her interests in every way possible, even to the shedding of blood, then such affiliation justly becomes a very important factor.

The July 23 issue of "Newsweek," beginning on page 21, speaks of Harriman's having

"some of the most experienced political navigators in either major political party," and says "one is Carmine De Sapio, grand sachme of Tammany Hall." The article then says that Tammany Hall (New York City's great Political Plunder Plotters) "was credited with making Alfred E. Smith the Presidential Candidate (in 1928)."

The article then states, "working for Harriman outside the headlines are ex-Postmaster General James A. Farley, Judge Samuel I. Rosenman, Democratic brain-truster from the early days of Franklin D. Roosevelt's New Deal; former New York Lt.

Gov. Charles Poletti; and Michael H. Pendergast, Democratic State Chairman." For over 25 years, James A. Farley has been the Number

One Catholic layman in America. Poletti and Pendergast are also Catholics of the deepest dye. Harry S. Truman is supposed to be a Baptist, but it was under the direction of old Uncle Tom Pendergast that he first went to Washington.

From what seems to be a third edition of a book by Rev. Chas. Chiniquy, an ex-Priest of the Catholic Church, copyrighted in 1886, page 668 and 669, I quote from some statements by some Catholic Priests to other Catholic Priests in an assembly at Buffalo in the spring of 1852, as follows:

"We are determined, like you, to take possession of the United States and rule them; but we cannot do that without acting secretly and with the utmost wisdom. If our plans are known, they will surely be defeated. — Silently and patiently, we must mass our Roman Catholics in the great cities of the United States, remembering that the vote of a poor journeyman, though he be covered with rags, has as much weight in the scale of power as the millionaire Astor, — let us then, multiply our votes; let us call our poor, but faithful Irish Catholics from every corner of the world, and gather them into the very hearts of these proud citadels which the Yankees are so rapidly building under the names of Washington, New York, Boston, Chicago, Buffalo, Albany, Troy, Cincinnati, etc. Under the shadows of these great cities, the Americans consider themselves as a

giant and unconquerable race. — Let us pray God that they may sleep and dream their sweet dreams, a few years more. How sad will be their awakening, when with our out numbering votes, we will turn them, forever, from every position of honor, power and profit! What will these hypocritical and godless sons and daughters of the fanatical Pilgrim Fathers say, when not a single judge, not a single teacher, not a single policeman will be elected if he be not a devoted Irish Roman Catholic? What will these so-called giants think of their matchless shrewdness and ability, when not a single Senator, or member of Congress will be chosen, if he be not submitted to our holy father, the Pope? What a sad figure those Protestants (Protestant) Yankees will cut when we will not only elect the President, but fill and command the armies, man the navies, and hold the keys of the public treasury? —"

And page 670 says, "Then, yes! then, we will rule the United States, and lay them at the feet of the Vicar of Jesus Christ, that he may put an end to their godless system of education, and sweep away those impious laws of liberty of conscience, which are an insult to God and man!"

In 1921 when one of the sugar king's asked for the choicest bloom of the Ashram to be sent to Wardha to start a similar type of an institution, Vinoba

was chosen. Over the years this rich man stripped himself of all his wealth in the service of the non-violence revolution dying as a simple laborer in one of the Ashrams started by Vinoba from money diverted from one of his sugar mills.

The Land Gift Mission was started in Bihar in 1961 and its aim was to persuade landlords in India to share their land with the landless. The leader of the movement is Vinoba Bhave. And while a chronic sufferer from dysentery, malaria and a stomach ulcer he travels by foot averaging about ten miles per day.
