churchmen who founded the in-stitution almost a century ago. The Founders' Day address was delivered by James H. Car-ter, a 1916 graduate and now Assistant to the President, Dr. Martin D. Jenkins. Mr. Carter is now in his forty-first year as a Morgan employee. a Morgan employee.

Morgan was founded in 1867

as the Centenary Biblical Insti-tute, named Morgan College in 1890 and became a state institution in 1939.

It has grown into one of the largest Maryland institutions of higher learning, servicing more than 2,000 students yearly with a regular faculty of 136 and buildings and grounds valued at an estimated 10 million dollars.
