for more than 80 years," the telegram declared.
The wire pointed out that on this key section of the bill five Republican members voted with 13 Southern Democrats to strike it out and declared that this action "placed a responsibility upon their party which cannot be shifted to the Southern Democrats."
The emasculated bill must now go to the House Rules Committee to get clearance to the House floor, but the Rules Committee chairman is Rep. Howard Smith of Virginia, an all-out foe of civil rights bills, who may use his great power as chairman to block the bill from the floor.
