Durhamite On Faculty of Va. School for Deaf

HAMPTON, VA.—Miss Martha Ann Thompson is one of the new additions to the staff at the Virginia State School here. A graduate of Shaw University, where she received her A. B. degree, Miss Thompson is the instructor-supervisor of the Ritter Hall girls'

dormitory at the school. A native of Durham, N. C., Miss Thompson has initiated a program geared toward teaching ethics and moral living to the student residents of Ritter Hall. A program to implement the teaching of a special vocabulary and language involved in the daily activities of the children is also under way.

Miss Thompson, who expects to complete the requirements for her master's degree in special education next summer at North Carolina College at Durham, is directly in charge of counseling the students in Ritter Hall. A-

mong her many functions is to counsel them, individually and in groups, on personal hygiene, study habits, and social activities. Also recently added to the staff of the school is Miss Lenora Ann Pritchett, a native of Greenville, Kentucky, who is a teacher of mathematics for the supper grades.
