

Martin King Recipient of 22nd Degree

JERSEY CITY, N. J.—SCLC President, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., this week publicly expressed his heartfelt gratitude and appreciation for the first honorary degree bestowed upon him by a Catholic educational institution.

Dr. King's expression of gratitude was directed to St. Peter's College, a Jesuit institution in Jersey City, New Jersey. The Nobel Peace Prize winner was awarded an Honorary Degree of Laws and Letters, his 22nd honorary degree, on September 22 at St. Peter's Michalmas Convocation.

In a citation to Dr. King St. Peter's headed by its president, the Very Reverend Victor R. Yanitelli, S. J., cited the head of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference for his nonviolent struggle to break down the barriers of hypocrisy and contradiction in American Society.

NEW YORK—Otto Preminger, director producer of "Bunny Lake Is Missing," a Columbia Pictures release, came to Harlem recently to appear on a radio program, in behalf of his latest motion picture.

Appearing on the "Lunch with Evelyn Cunningham at Frank's" radio show, broadcast from a Harlem landmark restaurant, Preminger told of his filming "Bunny Lake Is Missing" on location in London, without utilizing any studio facilities.

"Bunny Lake Is Missing," a suspense-thriller, had its world premiere Sunday (Oct. 3) at New York's Victoria Theater under the chairmanship of Mayor and Mrs. Robert F. Wagner for the benefit of the Police Athletic League.

Miss Evelyn Cunningham, the charming hostess of the midday radio show, discussed "Bunny Lake Is Missing," with the producer-director; and, other motion pictures he has filmed.

During recent years, Pre-

minger has assumed a secure position as one of the leading creative figures of the film industry, a trail-blazer in the selection of dynamic, unconventional stories, and in the discovery and utilization of new acting talent.

In addition, Preminger's efforts in the field of human rights and the furthering of Negroes in the acting profession, often in the face of criticism, is well known. One of his first independent productions was "Carmen Jones," and he has made use of Negro talent in many motion pictures, including Ossie Davis in "The Cardinal."

The next Preminger production, "Hurry Sundown," is a story of the American South, and may be filmed entirely on location in that part of the United States.

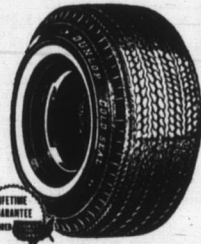
