

## St. Augustine's Choir Listed On ABC for June Broadcast

The choir of Oakwood College, Huntsville, Ala., will initiate the June series with a program of sacred music ranging from classical mas-

terworks to Negro spirituals. The program is to be broadcast the week of June 5. The Oakwood College choir is directed by Harold L. Anthony.

The choir of Bishop College in Dallas, Texas, will be featured the week of June 12; the choir of Saint Augustine's College, Raleigh, will be heard the week of June 19;

and the final broadcast of the month, during the week of June 26, will feature the choir of Virginia Union University, Richmond.

"Negro College Choirs" is carried by ABC affiliated stations throughout the country on varying days and at different hours.

## IUE Workers Launch Drive To Place 1500 Job Trainees

WASHINGTON, D. C.—The membership of the International Union of Electrical Workers is launching a massive recruitment drive to place 1,500 disadvantaged persons in on-the-job training programs, Secretary of Labor W. Willard Wirtz announced this week.

Under a \$156,376 Labor Department contract, the IUE will develop on-the-job training agreements initially in 12 cities where the electrical union has a concentration of members.

IUE membership will conduct a person-to-person, door-to-door campaign to seek out hard-case unemployed and underemployed persons for job training.

Electrical manufacturing firms, large and small, will provide the main source of local level training opportunities at the 12 cities selected for the opening drive are Pittsburgh, Philadelphia, New York, Cleveland, Cincinnati, Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Louis, Indianapolis, Boston, Newark, N. J., and Springfield, Mass.

Program director will be William S. Gary, Director of the Civil Rights and Minority Affairs Department of the IUE.

Paul J. Jennings, President of the IUE, who signed the Manpower Development and Training Act contract with Manpower Administrator S. H. Ruttenberg said: "The IUE is in the war against poverty, ignorance, discrimination, and disease with a total commitment. We believe that the voluntary efforts of more fortunate neighbors are needed to bring national programs to the people such programs are intended to help."

"The leadership of this labor organization as well as its membership are to be commended for this approach to the real problem of matching unprepared workers to worthwhile training programs and jobs," Ruttenberg said.

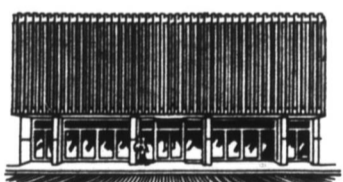

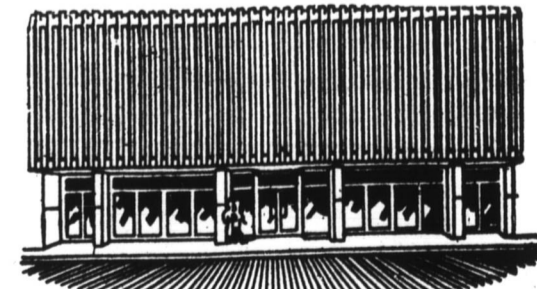
