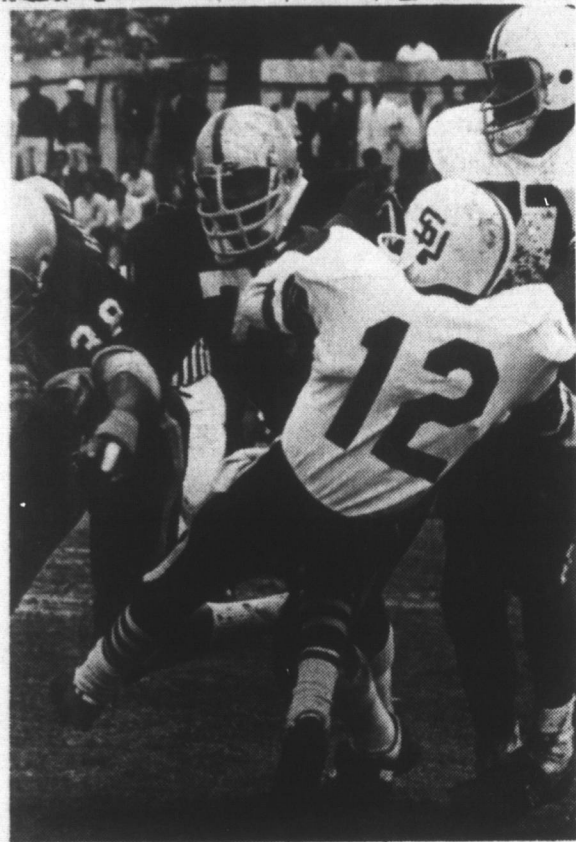

Johnson C. Smith's Bulls Defeat NCCU in High Scoring Contest

Two powerful football teams clashed Saturday in Durham and experience won as Johnson C. Smith's senior quarterback, Elroy Duncan, led the Golden Bulls to a 55-34 win over N. C. Central's Eagles.

The game was a football fan's dream, with long pass patterns, spectacular fumble recoveries, blocked kicks and passes, pass interceptions all playing a part in the results. Smith even lost and recovered a 23-point lead during the game.

The first touchdown came on the first play from scrimmage after Central's James Smith fumbled at his own 24. Duncan passed to Tim Beamer for the touchdown, and Larry Brown kicked the extra point for a 7-0 lead.

Central's first score came on a drive starting from a kick-off return, one of the few touchdowns scored after a conventional ball exchange. Jefferson Inmon's four-yard touchdown run was set up by a 17-yard pass from Garvin Stone to James Smith. Charles Bellingher's kick failed, and the score was 7-6.

The Bulls moved from their own 28 after a George Williams punt for the Eagles for their next touchdown. Two successive penalties against Central set up Duncan's touchdown pass to his lumbering freshman tight end, Freddy

Harris, from the 13.

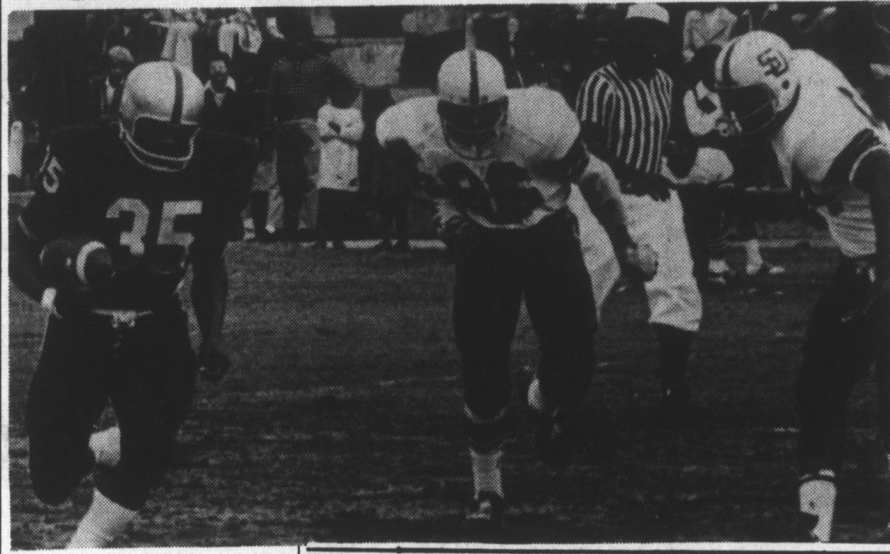
Another pass to Harris climaxed Smith's next drive, which started with a fumble recovery at the Smith 47. Duncan threw 30 yards to Joe Johnson for the next touchdown for the Bulls, and the Eagles were behind 21 points, 27-6.

Three Central touchdowns in succession followed. Stone threw 17 yards to Mike Carter for the first with Jefferson Inmon carrying for two points. Jefferson Inmon carried for five yards for Central's third touchdown of the game, and Inmon carried for six points from the six after a fumbled kickoff was recovered in Smith territory. James Smith's two-point carry gave the Eagles the lead, 28-27, but only momentarily.

Deep in their own territory after stopping a Smith threat with a fumble recovery, the Eagles elected to kick on third down. A bad pass from center resulted in a safety, and Smith had regained the lead, 29-28.

Central was forced to kick-off after the safety, and Smith returned that kickoff to Central's 49 with the aid of a personal foul penalty. The Bulls then moved to the touchdown. A 30-yard pass from Duncan to Beamer set up Beamer's four-yard scoring run. Brown's kick was good, and the score at halftime was 36-28, Johnson C. Smith.

Smith's Thomas Baldwin returned a blocked punt to Central's 20, setting up a Duncan to Beamer Touchdown

Smith led 42-28.

A kickoff and two plays from scrimmage later, Smith's John Fairley reacted quickly as a blocked Garvin Stone pass fell into his hands. The big lineman dashed for a touchdown, and Brown's kick brought Smith's margin back to 21.

That margin was lost temporarily when Stone threw to Caldwell in the end zone for the first score of the fourth quarter. The 34-yard pass was followed by a pass to Mahlon Williams in the try for two points, but a penalty nullified Williams' reception. The second attempt failed, and Smith retained a 15-point lead.

Durham's Otis Jones recovered a Roy Anderson fumble at Central's eight-yard line, and Willie Sutton scored on a four-yard try from the one, for the final score of the game.
