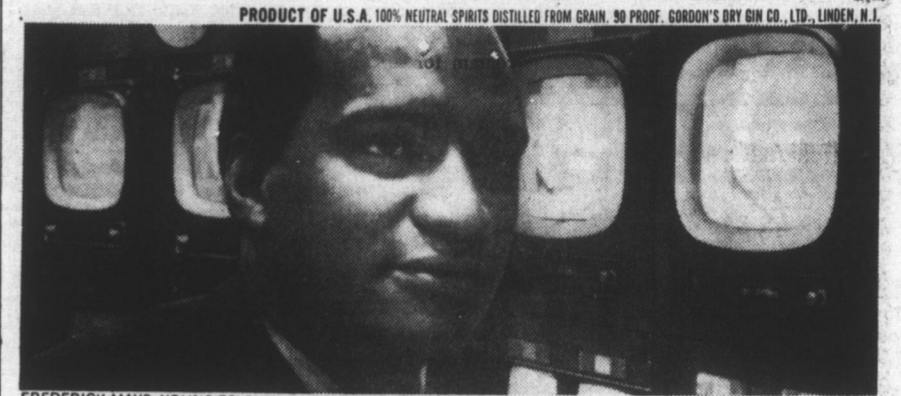

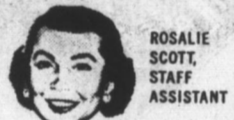

## cooking hints

Use left-over turkey for Corn Bread Topped Turkey Pie. This tasty casserole stays moist because it is made with Velvitized Evaporated Milk. Your family will like it.



CORN BREAD TOPPED TURKEY PIE (Makes 4 servings)

| 2 tablespoons butter                      | 1 1/4 cups (10 1/2-ounce can) cream of chicken soup |
| 2 tablespoons flour                       | 1 cup cooked peas                                   |
| 1 teaspoon salt                           | 1/4 cup chopped pimiento                            |
| 1/4 teaspoon pepper                       | 1 1/2 cups cubed left-over turkey                   |
| 1/4 teaspoon oregano                      |   |
| 1 cup undiluted Carnation Evaporated Milk |   |

Melt butter in saucepan. Add flour, salt, pepper and oregano. Stir until blended. Gradually stir in Carnation Evaporated Milk. Cook until slightly thickened. Add cream of chicken soup. Stir until smooth and thickened. Add peas, pimiento and turkey. Stir until blended. Pour into shallow 1 1/2-quart casserole. Drop corn bread by heaping tablespoonfuls on top. | 1/2 cup sifted flour          | 1 slightly beaten egg                       |
| 1 1/4 teaspoons baking powder | 1/2 cup undiluted Carnation Evaporated Milk |
| 1/2 cup yellow corn meal      | 2 tablespoons water                         |
| 1/2 teaspoon salt             |   |
| 2 tablespoons shortening      |   |

Sift flour, baking powder, corn meal and salt together. Cut in shortening until well blended. Add egg, Carnation Evaporated Milk and water. Mix until just blended.

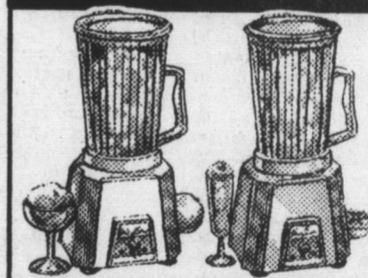
