

than anyone, and the com-mon cold spreads rapidly through a school community before it goes home to infect entire families.



atric strengths of 1/8 and 1/4%. They should be used according to package instructions, or as directed by the

physician.
The child with a cold and fever often loses body fluid when the fever makes him perspire. He becomes "dried out;" which lowers his resistance to germs still more. Drinking milk, water, fruit juices, and carbonated beverages helps to prevent dehydration.

To help prevent spread of infection at school and at home it is wise to have every member of the family (and at school, every member of the class, if possible) wash hands frequently with an antibac-terial skin cleanser such as pHisoHex. The cold victim should also be carefully in-structed to cover his coughs and sneezes, and to place soiled paper tissues in a disposable receptacle.
