Every now and then someone looks up from the tracks ahead to the hills around him and he sees the world he has forsaken, the reality he has ignored. But the tracks cry out to him, one more bridge and you make it, and the tracks behind him cry out to you can do it, forget about them out there.
And the lonely voice of youth cries out through tears, through blood, through pain, in anguish, why must the world be like this, help me change it, together we can. I don't want to know the life that you tread. Let me comfort, let me feed, let me heal, let me give, let me love.
The world laughs at youth, the world tolerates youth, the world even listens to youth. But the world does not lose sight of the road of rails it

has prepared. And so youth cry, they whimper, and they die. The idealism, the beauty, the truth, the perfection, the love, they die. The tracks claim life, and the world is soon forgotten as man blindly pursues the life of the tracks.
And he dies.

LEAF SUPPLY DOWN

While there is no danger of a shortage occurring anytime soon, the U. S. flue-cured tobacco supply continues to decline. The supply is off 2 percent from a year ago. The 1971 crop is estimated at about 9 percent below 1970's. During the past marketing year, exports fell off slightly and domestic use dropped 6 percent.
