\$100,000 Damage To Atom Smasher Caused By Bombs

STANFORD, Calif. Bombs did more than \$100,000 damage to the world's longest atom smasher Tuesday, officials at the Stanford Linear Accelerator reported.

Two explosions ripped the west end of the two-mile-long accelerator shortly before 8:30 a.m. when workmen discovered the damage, officials said.

The \$114 million accelerator is located in isolated, grassy foothills west of the Stanford University campus.

No one was injured, there was no fire and no radiation leak, university officials said. Stanford operates the accelerator for the Atomic Energy Commission.

Nearby residents reported hearing explosions between 7:10 and 8 a.m.

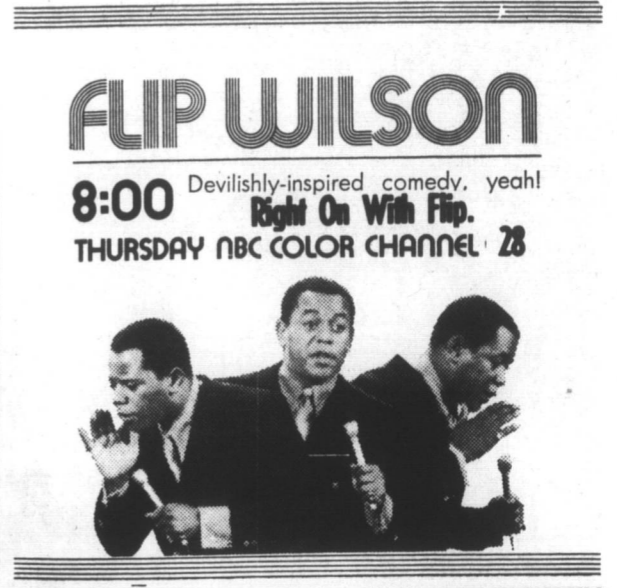
