\$100,000 Damage To Atom Smasher **Caused By Bombs**

STANFORD, Calif. Bombs did more than \$100,000 damage to the world's longest atom smasher Tuesday, offi-cials at the Stanford Linear Accelerator reported. Two explosions ripped the

west end of the two-mile-long accelerator shortly before 8:30 a.m. when workmen discovered the damage, officials said.

The \$114 million accelerator is located in isolated, grassy foothills west of the Stanford University campus.

No one was injured, there was no fire and no radiation leak, university officials said. Stanford operates the accelera-tor for the Atomic Energy Commission. Nearby residents reported

hearing explosions between 7:10 and 8 a.m.

It was the first reported vio-lence at Stanford since terrorists bombed university Presi-dent Richard Lyman's office last April, said information officer Bob Beyers

University officials said they had no idea who bombed the atom smasher or why. They said no classified work was carried on and the center formed no defense work. per-
