of adult and legal education as well as to introduce for making available Black Studies for inmates. This committee will also assist in a study release program for the inmates in applying to area colleges for admission.

4. The Political Prisoners Subcommittee will investigate the disciplinary procedures, rules, regulations, and rights, etc., induced upon the inmates.

5. The Talent Search Subcommittee will solicit the talented brothers and sisters in art, music, poetry, and writing for the purpose of exposing their works to the public through the media and exhibitions in the future. There has been numerous responses from creative brothers in the areas of poetry and art.

6. The Correspondence Subcommittee will handle all incoming mail from inmates. Presently BLC is corresponding with approximately 60 or 65 inmates. The correspondence has been beneficial in highlighting the specific problems that prevail and useful in building morale for those inmates who receive little or no mail. This particular area of the BLC activities is increasing considerably.

An appeal has been made to Black churches and organizations in the community on behalf of BLC for the purpose of requesting financial assistance in the establishment of a defense fund. The purpose of the fund is to help brothers and sisters who, because of financial difficulties, are unable to obtain legal representation.

At present, the BLC has been working with the mother of Brother James Sneed who has been accused and confined for the October slaying of a State Trooper in Roxboro.

These and other efforts are being used by the Black Liberation Committee to help alleviate the alienation of our brothers and sisters incarcerated by the Penal System.
