Woman's **NEW SPRAY CONTAINER**

DISPENSES HAND-CREAM Tired of hand-cream jars that are too deep for your fingers? According to a survey taken by Fuller Brush Company many women are. Getting the cream out of

its container by hand can sometimes be difficult and messy. But Fuller with the help of Plant Industries, Inc., believes it has solved these problems,



Plant Industries developed the first non-aerosol dispensing container. It's called SELVAC, for self evacuating. And Fuller is the first to use it.

Putting hand-cream in a SELVAC container provides convenience. Milady merely pushes on an actuator and out comes the cream. She rubs the cream onto her hands and it's done. No wiping excess cream off the jar.

And the fat, round handcream jar sitting on the dressing table can be replaced by an asethetic container. SELVAC fits any decorative shape and can be used with any material. If a paper jar was called for, SELVAC could work within

SELVAC containers dis-pense products by a bladder system. The bladder resembles a balloon. It's this balloon that is filled with the product. Then, as the actuator is pressed the balloon contracts, forcing out the product. Obviously, only product is placed in the balloon. No propellent is need-

The absence of a propel-lent means SELVAC containers are safe. They can't ex-plode. They have no irritating additives, They can be safely disposed of. And they dispense around 95 percent of the product.

Another good feature. SELVAC isn't restricted to creams. Plant Industries says it will work on shampoos, lotions, toothpastes and many other household products.

\$19 BILLION NET

First estimates indicate that U.S. net farm income in 1972 was a near record \$19 billion, up sharply from the \$16.1 billion in 1971.
