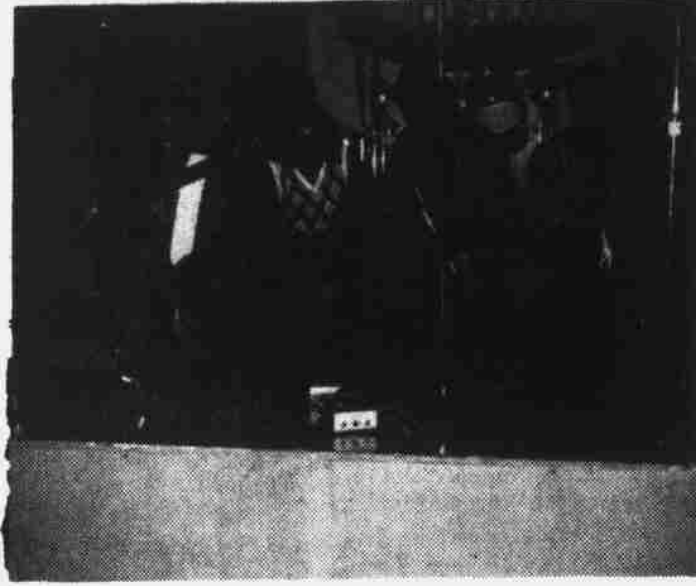


THE SOUL PERSUADERS — YOUNG GROUP ON WAY UP THE LADDER OF SUCCESS

campaign headquarters in the bridge building at Morgan and Boylan Streets on the western edge of Raleigh's business district.

Two assistant campaign directors will man the Raleigh office. They are Tom Adams, who left U. S. "I consider the post of State Treasurer to be at least the second most important position in state government," said Brown.

"The State Treasurer is the state's banker, serving as its chief fiscal officer," the candidate noted.

"He receives and disburses state funds, administers our bonded debt and invests all eligible state monies."

The State Treasurer also serves as the chief trustee of state retirement funds and as Director of the Local Government Commission.

He chairs the Tax Review Board and the State Banking Commission, and is a member of the State Board of Education as well as the Council of State.

(Continued From Page 1) North Carolina are indebted, to Gill, who "has done an outstanding job over the years in safeguarding and prudently investing the state's funds."

In his announcement, Brown stressed the importance of the state treasurer's post and his own legislative, professional and political experience.

Appropriations and Finance Committees of the House has given me important insight into our state's financial structure," he said.

"I have been subject to the pressures on our legislature in respect to the allocation of our state's resources and of our tax burden," he added.

Brown, a legislator since 1971, holds a degree in accounting as well as a law degree from the University of

North Carolina at Chapel Hill. In 1973, Brown was chairman of the campaign in support of the statewide school construction bond referendum which carried the state with a 70% majority.

He also stated that he was "confident that I can both support and complement the Democratic ticket in November," if nominated in the August primary.
