Sears Foundation Aids **Durham College Library**

The Board of Trustees, administration, faculty and staff of Durham College has launched a \$100,000 Educational Improvement Fund for the purpose of finishing the renovation of the new library facility and to complete the equipping of its new gym-

Various people and organi-zations have afforded donations in support of the drive.

Among the most recent is the Sears-Roebuck Foundation. Grants totaling more than \$47,000 were distributed to twenty-nine privately supported colleges and universities in North Carolina by the Foundation, a spokesman said.

Duke University and Durham College have received grants totaling \$11,100 in the Durham area. The North Carolina

colleges and universities are among almost 1,000 private accredited two and four year institutions across the

country which are sharing in \$1,250,000 in Sears Founda-

The chart above shows a including 4 black lawyers, long known and existing three of whom are females. Edmisten's department is the only state department that has begun to implement an affirmative action plan.

A report was not made on the status of black employ-ment within the N. C. Department of Administration, the closest department to the Governor. Joseph Grimsley, Hunt's campaign manager, is director of the department which has 41 policy making jobs, the highest of any state agency. The CCNS survey showed that blacks have been appointed to only three of the 41 positions. Harold Webb, John Edwards, and Frank Turner hold the positions. Grimsley's personnal staff, excluding one receptionist are all white.

Dr. Allison held an imressive computer print-out of jobs in state government and disclosed glaring discrepancies in previous hiring of blacks at levels except the lowest state government. Below are seven categories of employment and the number of blacks hired at each level: Level No. 1 - \$25,000


