Neither team mounted a serious scoring threat until the Eagles recovered a muffed handoff from Mizelle to Thomas on the VUU 45. Eagle quarterback Charles Armwood passed the Eagles to the VUU 9 where the Panthers defense forced the Eagles back to the VUU 13. Junior kicker Eric Hines came in and gave the Eagles what appeared to be the winning points with a 30-yard field goal with 11:18 left in the game.

The Panthers appeared to be doomed as they were unable to move in their next offensive series. The Eagles started on their 46 yard line and marched to the VUU 20 behind the running of fullback James Lawrence, who picked up 18 yards in the drive. Armwood's fumble at the VUU 21 gave the Panthers their last ray of hope.

The Panthers' Frank Drak snuffed out the Eagles lights by intercepting Armwood's pass intended for tight end Joe Mack on the NCCU 48 and returning it 33 yards to the NCCU 15 with 10 second left in the game.

The Eagles amassed 92 yards rushing and 111 yards passing while holding the Panthers to 56 yards rushing and 82 yards passing.

Linebackers Walt Odom, Chris Smith, cornerback Ray Irby and tackles Thomas Gilmer and Randal Evans paced an improved Eagles defense. Odom was the leading tackler with 2 unassisted and 16 assisted tackles. Smith had 1 unassisted and 9 assisted tackles. Irby had 1 unassisted and 8 assisted tackles, while Gilmer had 2 unassisted and 7 assisted tackles, including 2 quarterback sacks. Evans, an All-American candidate, chipped in 2 unassisted and 6 assisted tackles and 1 fumble recovery and 1 1/2 quarterback sacks.

Offensively, the Eagle Armwood completed 9 of 16 passes for 111 yards and 1 touchdown.

Lawrence was the leading Eagles rusher with 50 yards in 13 attempts. Delasio Bartley chipped in 31 yards in 6 tries.

Tight end Joseph Mack caught 6 passes for 69 yards and 1 touchdown. Bassett latched onto 2 passes for 33 yards.

Fish Bowl Classic Set For Portsmouth, Va. On Sept. 24

PORTSMOUTH, VA. - The 30th annual Fish Bowl football classic, sponsored by Arabia Temple 12, Prince Hall Shriners in Virginia, will be played in the Frank D. Lawrence stadium in Portsmouth, Va., on Saturday, September 24 starting at 2 p.m.

The gridiron game will be a regular CIAA contest pitting the Norfolk State College Spartans against a strong Elizabeth State University team from Elizabeth City. A capacity crowd of more than 15,000 is expected.

Skinner, Jr., illustrious potentate of the temple from Virginia Beach, Va., extends a cordial invitation to nobles, daughters, and friends of PH shriners, worldwide, to attend. He said that headquarters for the Fish Bowl classic will be the Holiday Inn of Portsmouth, located near the U. S. Naval Hospital in the city.

They forced Ellsworth Turner A&T's fine quarterback, into a number of interceptions, and returned them for great field position. The stubborn Rams recovered a Turner fumble in A&T's end of the field, and they shut down the Aggies' running game. McKinley admitted that interceptions and fumbles deep in the A&T territory hurt, but believes once those problems are ironed out, his team can come back.

A&T was hardly ever in the game, though the score stood 7-6 early in the first half. After that, the packed stadium watched the Winston-Salem State Rams devastate the home-standing Aggies and balloon the score to 30-6. They stared in awe as the Rams methodically turned A&T mistakes into quick scores.

Rick Holland, senior running back for the Aggies, said that inexperience played a part in the loss. He believes that it is up to the veterans to motivate younger players, and after they do, A&T will be challenging for the M. E. A. C. crown. Winston-Salem is a member of the C. I. A. A.
