Called a capital press conference to urge passage of the federal Equal Rights Amendment.
 -Testified in support of an Internal Revenue Service proposal to deny tax exemptions to private schools which practice race discrimination, and;
 -Held a two-day consultation on police practices.
STATE AMENDMENTS: The 32-page report cited how ERA is working in those states which have added amendments to their constitutions.
 Public benefits in area ranging from criminal and civil law to education and employment are described.
FEDERAL AMENDMENT: So far, 35 of the needed 38 states have ratified the federal Equal Rights Amendment.
 Three more must sign off before the new Congressional deadline of June 30 1982.
 The Commissioners held a news conference to reiterate their "vigorous support" of federal ratification.
 "The sooner the better," they said.
TAX EXEMPTIONS: Chairman Arthur Flemming stated the Commission position: Court decisions "not only justify, but mandate" adoption of proposed procedures to withhold tax exemptions from private schools which violate federal nondiscrimination policies.
 He called it a "long-overdue step" and promised that the Commission would be monitoring IRS implementation.
POLICE PRACTICES: The Commission consultation, part of a national study, addressed such issues as firearms policies, recruitment, remedies for misconduct, and use of deadly force.
 It involves national police experts and critics.
