for up to three months. It is the first foreign-based investigating mission to successfully penetrate ex-tensive areas of the Philippine countryside under martial law conditions.

The team managed to cover practically all key community struggles in the country's three regions: Mindanao, Visaysa, and Luzon. Direct investigation revealed that refugee communities are indeed large and growing, with people barely eking out a living from odd jobs and irregular government handots. The continuous growth of the number of refuguees attributed to onmilitary
