**Regan Henry Speaks
Radio, TV Ownership Said
In Reach of Blacks**

GREENSBORO, N.C. — Blacks can increasingly become owners of radio and television stations, if they are willing to pay their dues, the nation's top black broadcast manager said here Saturday.

Ragan Henry, whose Broadcast Enterprises Network Inc. firm of Philadelphia already owns six radio stations, made the remark during the second annual A&T State University mass media conference.

Henry, the Harvard-trained lawyer and broadcast executive, pointed out that the Special Task Force of the National Association of Broadcasters is committed to raising \$15 million for "seed capital" to

support minority persons wanting to own a broadcast station. Henry said the \$15 million could total \$300 million in acquisitions "if it is used right."

"Entry into ownership is becoming and will continue to become easier for blacks," he said. "Many are willing to predict the tripling of minority ownership in three years."

Another speaker at the conference, ABC News anchorman Max Robinson, said he believes "if black people find it in their interest to become owners—and they certainly should—then it will be done, in

my estimation."

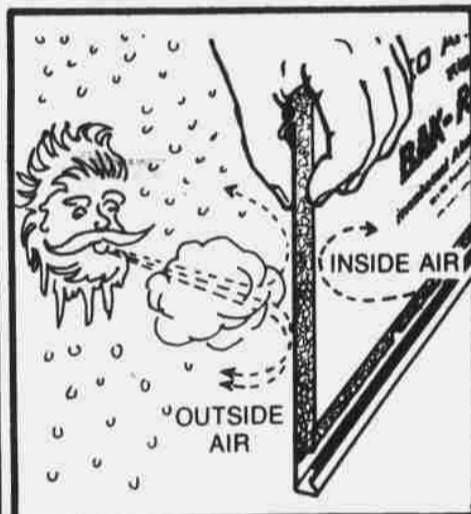

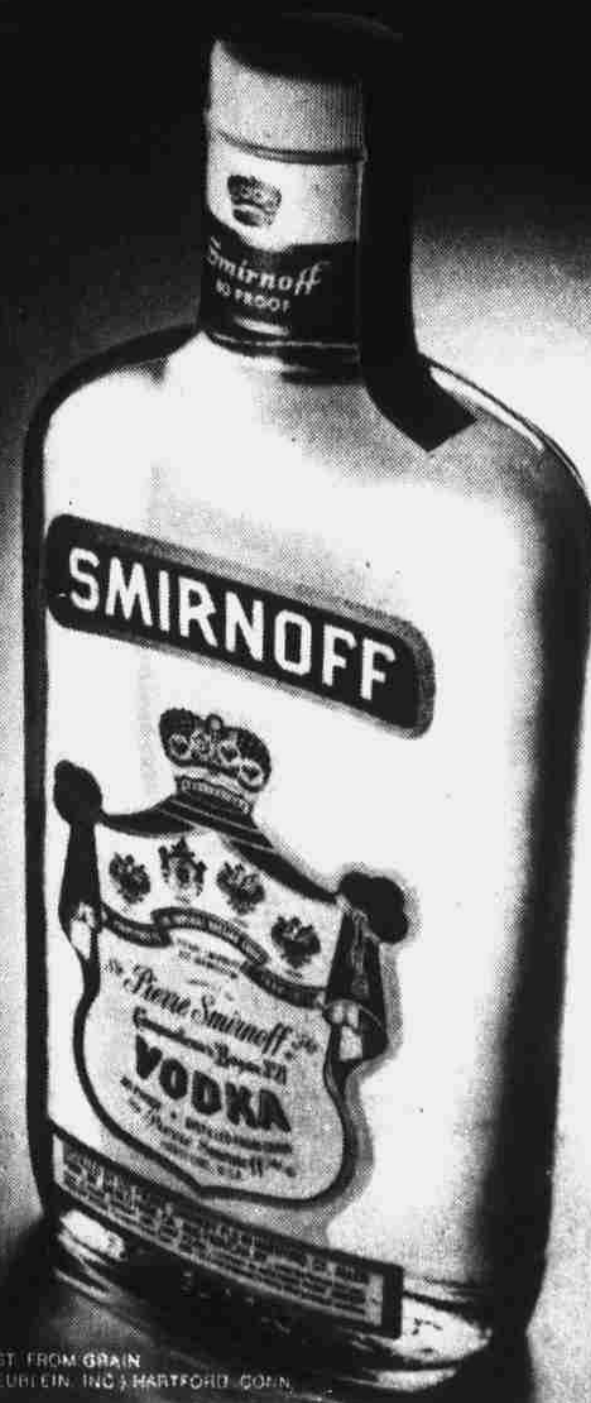
