NEW YORK — "Black business is beautiful but it is also fragile," said David Mahoney, chairman of the Board and Chief Executive Officer of Norton Simon, Inc. as he addressed the 1979 National Dinner of the Interracial Council for Business Opportunity. Mahoney, who

heads a major international consumer marketing company, charged that the corporate community has an obligation in supporting minority business. The dinner, held at the New York Hilton, was the most successful in the 16-year history of ICBO with 1,400 guests. Dr. Andrew F. Brimmer, noted economist and former member of the Federal Reserve Board, was announced as the new national co-chairman of the ICBO Board.

Ms. Allene Roberts, program coordinator, training materials, Philip Morris USA, were among the Black Achievers in Industry honored at a dinner recently sponsored by the Harlem Branch YMCA at the New York Hilton.

Theodore C. "Ted" Jackson, recently promoted to Executive Vice President of the Bowery Savings Bank, was saluted last week at the monthly meeting of the 100 Black Men. The Bowery, with assets of over \$5.1 billion, is the largest mutual savings bank in New York State and the second largest in the nation. Jackson is in charge of all branch operations, bank buildings and data processing activities.
