KENNY ROGERS AND AMERICAN COWBOY

Kenny Rogers, one of the country's hottest recording artists, stars in his second television special, 'Kenny Rogers and the American Cowboy,' which intermixes performances in concert with his guest stars Mac Davis (right, with Rogers) and The Charlie Daniels Band, and an on-location look at the life and music of real working cowboys, to be presented WEDNESDAY, NOV. 28 on CBS-TV.

The location footage was shot at two enormous ranches, one north of Elko, Nev., and the other in south-central Oregon. Rogers got a chance to live out a common childhood fantasy, spending several days living, working and swapping songs around the campfire with the buckaroos.
