Samuel L. Gravely joined the Navy as an enlisted man in the early days of World War II. After 30 years and service in three wars, he rose through the ranks to the top.

Gravely was promoted to the rank of rear admiral on May 15, 1971, thus becoming the first black man to hold flag rank in the history of the U.S. Navy.

He was one of 49 chosen for promotion admiral from a list of 2,000 eligible officers. The Senate confirmed Gravely's appointment without debate.
