

Teenage Pageant

DANVILLE, VA. — 1981 will mark the ninth anniversary of the annual Miss Black Teenage World Pageant. Ron Charity, founder and producer, has announced that "plans are in the works for the biggest and best pageant production in our history. Our pageant theme, 'Moving On Up', will serve as focal point for many exciting pageant events."

The Miss Black Teenage World Pageant is registered with the U.S. Patent Office and is open to young ladies 15 to 17 years old. Contestants must compete in five segments of competition: Sportswear (no swimsuits), Creative Expression, Talent, Evening Wear and Personal Projection. Many unique features set MBTW apart from other similar programs. One such feature is the Pageant's Personal Development Seminar, which deals with subjects designed to increase the teenagers' self-awareness

and self-confidence. The current titleholder is Miss Frettra Miller, a student at Highland Park Senior High School in St. Paul, Minnesota. Miss Miller won the title at the annual pageant held in Chicago, Illinois.
