Since Atlanta Mayor Maynard jackson issued a nationwide TV appeal in October, the deaths and disappearances of fifteen black youngsters have prompted strangers from acrosss the nation to contribute thousands of dollars to a reward fund that now totals more than \$136,000.

Stephen Pullens, a twenty-year-old championship athlete and son of a Minneapolis elementary school principal, is fighting his discharge from the Air Force Academy because he bears the genetic trait for sickle cell anemia. A class action suit has been filed in federal court. The Air Force claims that people with the trait may experience special problems with a combination of stress and high altitudes. "The key word here is 'may'," says Pullens' lawyer. "There is no proven relationship between the trait and altitude problems."

Four black apartment seekers have filed a class action in federal court charging Warbasse Houses, a 99% white, state-subsidized coop in Brooklyn, with racial discrimination in its admission practices. The Open Housing Center was instrumental in bringing the suit which also names the State Division of Housing as a defendant. Among the complaints is one that a waiting list used by the coop is composed only of children of coop residents.

The U.S. Department of Justice has charged Yonkers and White Plans, NY, both in Westchester County, with sexual and racial discrimination in the hiring of police officers. Yonkers has also been accused school perpetuating segregation by building most of its subsidized housing where minorities were concentrated.
