## **National** Geographic Studies Ancient Arts Of Japan

Many nations designate their finest structures, monuments and physical features as national landmarks, but Japan alone recognizes by law its most Revered as gifted artists.

"Living Treasures," these individuals are officially designated by the Japanese Government as "Holders of Important Intangible Cultural Properties.'

Nine of these artisans and performing artists who keep the heartbeat of an ancient culture pulsing through a contemporary society are the subjects of the new National Geographic Special, "Living Treasures of Japan" that airs on the UNC Center for Public Television Wednesday, February 11 at 8 p.m. on Channel 4.

There are some 70 Living Treasures working in Japan today, most of them elderly, all venerated and addressed as

"sensei" - teacher. Many were teenagers when they began what has become their life's work. Receiving government stipends, they are charged with the obligation to publicly exhibit their work and to teach their artistry to apprentices, thus ensuring that it will live from one generation to the next.

This National Geographic Special introduces us to nine of the Living Treasures - a potter, dollmaker, puppeteer, papermaker, koto musician, swordmaker, textile weaver and dyer, Kabuki theater actor and bellmaker.

Writer/producer Miriam Birch notes that the artists do not produce their work in a

vacuum. They are revered, but at the same time very wellknown, and their work is exhibited not only in museums and in homes but also in public theaters and department stores. Theirs is popular

"They are so highly

respected," Birth adds, that they're usually treated with great deference. Even the man in the street is aware of these people through their many public exhibitions. Not even our biggest movie stars in America are so elevated by their fans."

## Hallmark Hall of Fame Brings Mr. Lincoln To Center

The complex and engaging personality of Abraham Lincoln comes to life on "Mister Lincoln," airing Monday, February 9 at 9 p.m. On Center Channel 4. Starring British actor Roy Dotrice in a one-man performance, the 90-minute Hallmark Hall of Fame special dramatizes Lincoln's life and mind - his rich wit and humor as well as his statesmanship and pathos.

The full range of this great and humane personality is finely etched in the script of Herbert Mitgang, Lincoln scholar and New York Times columnist. Videotaped earlier this year at Ford's Theatre in Washington, D. C., where Lincoln was fatally shot in 1965, the play is a dramatic retrospective of key moments in our 16th President's life those of both historial and personal significance.

As portrayed by dotrice, Lincoln emerges as one whose incisive wit prevailed even in dire circumstances. For example, he was informed by telegram that the Battle of Bull Run — the war's first — had produced a surprising booty.
"We have captured six cows," the wire said. "What shall we do with them? Lincoln's "Please milk response: them."

Challenged and tormented by the terrible war and by growing political hostility, Lincoln had to endure private hardships as well: his "old melancholia;" his wife's increasing mental instability; his vivid nightmares - one of which was to foresee his own assassination.

"Mister Lincoln" is the first in a series of three Hallmark Hall of Fame specials premiering on Center in 1981. On
