

# Nominations For N.C. Awards Open March 1

Nominations for the 1981 North Carolina Awards, the highest honors given by the state, will be accepted from March 1 through the end of May.

The annual awards, now in their 18th year, are presented

in four categories — fine arts, literature, science and public service. The gold medallions recognize North Carolinians who have made exceptional contributions to the state throughout their careers.

"This is the best chance North Carolinians have to honor their fellow citizens," according to Sara W. Hodgkins, secretary of the N. C. Department of Cultural Resources. "We encourage nominations from everyone."

Nominations, including biographies, resumes and letters of support, should be sent to Dr. Lawrence Wheeler, deputy secretary of the Department of Cultural

Resources, Raleigh, NC, 27611.

A citizens' committee will review nominations and recommend award winners to Secretary Hodgkins and Governor James B. Hunt Jr.

Governor Hunt will present the awards later in the year.

The North Carolina Awards were established by the General Assembly in 1961 on a motion by the late Dr. Robert Lee Humber, then state senator from Pitt County.

Last year's winners include Governor and Mrs. Dan K. Moore of Raleigh in public service; Fred Chappel of Greensboro in literature; Robert Lindgren of Winston-

Salem in fine arts; and George Hitchings of Durham in science.

occasionally a fifth award is presented to a North Carolinian living outside the

state. In 1979, for example, a special public service award went to John D. deButts, former chairman of the board of A.T.&T. and a Greensboro native.

## Captivating Suspense-Filled Drama Premieres On Center

It is England, 1924. Sir Richard Hannay has been asked by the authorities to recover three hostages — an Oxford undergraduate, a millionaire's daughter and a ten-year-old boy — who have been kidnapped by a mysterious crime syndicate planning a major coup in Europe and America. *Three Hostages* follows Sir Richard Hannay (Barry Foster) as he analyzes clue after clue in his search when this thriller premieres Wednesday, March 4 at 8 p.m. On Center Channel 4.

The tangled web begins to unravel when the first clues lead to Dominick Medina, an elegant politician with sinister political aspirations, a socialite and, unknown to Hannay, a master of hypnosis. Medina attempts to bring Hannay under his control by using his power.

Hannay resists but pretends to fall victim in hopes of securing additional clues about the hostages.

Hannay's patience and deceit with Medina lead him to Norway, where the first hostage is found, Lord Mercot, the undergraduate, whose mind is totally controlled by Medina.

Meanwhile, Hannay's wife, Mary has been helping with the search. She finds a zombie in a sleazy nightclub (it's the millionaire's daughter) and the ten-year-old boy in a massage parlor, hypnotized and disguised as a girl.

With Medina's masquerade revealed and political ambitions crushed, the Hannays mistakenly view him as a defeated man. Medina, however, is unwilling to concede defeat and seeks revenge.
