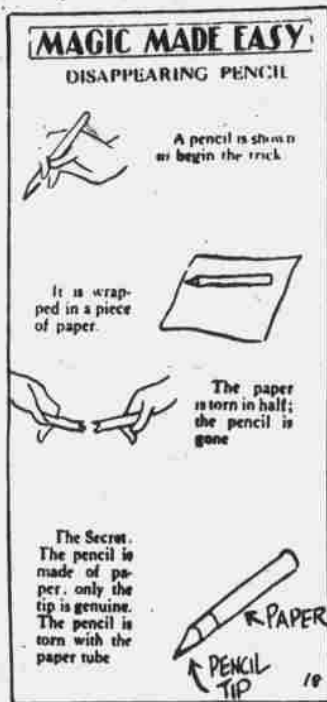

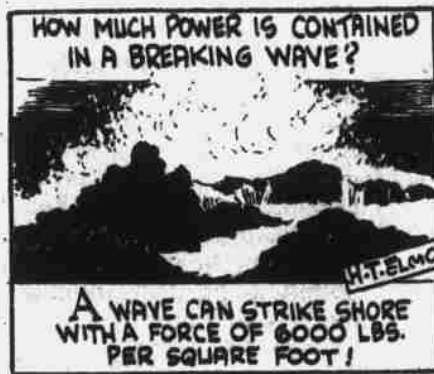

BLACK GIANTS



After the British reinforcements marched through Menotomy, Mass., Capt. Benjamin Locke mustered his Minutemen and swiftly followed in their wake. It was early on the morning of April 19, 1775. Only hours before, the first shots of the Revolution had been fired at Lexington and Concord.

Capt. Locke took every able-bodied man he could find when he marched off after the British. Left behind to protect the town were the old men of Menotomy who were exempt from military duty because of their age.

There were perhaps a dozen of them, organized as an "alarm company." Some accounts say a Negro named David Lamson commanded the group. Other accounts identify the leader as Philip Payson of Chelsea.

At first the British took it as a joke. Then they began to fight. A number of shots were fired. Finally some of the British thought better of it and fled.

Though aged, Lamson served the cause at least once more. He was in a company marched at the request of Gen. Washington to help take possession of Dorchester Heights. When this high ground overlooking Boston was taken, the British had to evacuate the city.
