Grad Student To Base Book On Thesis

Ms. Josephine Jordan, a graduate student at North Carolina Central University who has completed course work for the Master of Arts degree in psychology, is currently doing experimental study on "The Effects of Erotic Stimuli in the Improvement of Sexual Functioning." Ms. Jordan plans to use her findings as a basis for a book.

A thesis proposal, submitted to her thesis committee, comprised of Dr. Barbara Nixon (chairman), Dr. Richard Mizelle and Dr. Barnetta White, has been approved.
