Katherine Hepburn Spotlighted In Two Festival Programs

Three-time Academy Award winner Katharine Hepburn is featured in two special presentations during public television's FESTIVAL NIGHTS. The Lion In Winter, for which Hepburn won her third



Oscar, makes its television premiere on Wednesday, March 18 at 8 p.m. (repeats March 22 at 1 p.m.) and Starring Katharine Hepburn, a retrospective of her 50-year career in movies, airs Thursday, March 19 at 9 p.m. on Center Channel 4.

The Lion In Winter, sets in the castles and landscapes of Medieval England, is a masterful domestic comedy set in the treacherous context of international statecraft and royal intrigue.

Peter O'Toole stars as Henry II, the first Plantagenet king of England. Brilliant at both conquest (he expanded the British empire to include Ireland, Scotland, Wales and half of continental France) and diplomacy, his strength of will was equalled by that of his wife, the rich and powerful Eleanor of Aquitaine, herself a master diplomat, who was the first woman ever to be, in turn, queen of both France and England.

Katharine Hepburn plays Eleanor, whose extraordinary character both pleased and threatened Henry who kept her locked out of sight for sixteen years, except for Christmas Courts and other state occasions.

The intense struggle for succession among their three sons, Richard (the Lionhearted), Geoffrey and

John, provides yet another round of personal and political conflict between Eleanor and Henry, whose private lives must always find their roots and consequences in matters of state. Lovers and adversaries, the royal couple play out their relationship in a passionate comedy which is elegant in language and rich in irony.

Starring Katharine Hepburn, traces Hepburn's career in nearly 40 films from her first movie for RKO in1932, "A Bill of Divorcement," to her recent, the soon-to-be-released, "On Golden Pond."

This special two-hour presentation features film

clips, newsreels, stills and interviews with those who know the actress, including Henry and Jane Fonda, Lauren Bacall, John Houseman and Peter O'Toole, as well as excerpts from Hepburn's Oscarwinning performances in "Morning Glory" (1933), "Guess Who's Coming to Dinner" (1967) and "The Lion in Winter" (1968), and highlights from her films with Spencer Tracy.

Footage of her 1950 arrival in Africa with Humphrey Bogart and Lauren Baccl for the filming of "The African Queen" and of her Australian Shakespear tour are also part of the program.
