(Continued from Front) blighted picture that is often painted about the Durham City schools, he is optimistic about the schools, and believes that newcomers to the Triangle area will no longer be reluctant to move to Durham because of past adverse publicity that the city schools have received in the media.

"I am happy to see that no elementary school was closed last fall, and there is already a move back to the city," Rodenhizer said.

Many of Durham's residents, especially the poor, elderly and minorities, have expressed before the council their dissatisfaction with the positions taken by the majority of the council on several issues. Some of these issues are the East-West Expressway, the St. Theresa Development plan, the rescinding of the policy on utility rate increases, the proposed bus fare hike, the Durham Housing Authority and the earlier plan to reorganize the city's Affirmative Action program.
