

# Roxboro Area Deltas Charter Chapter

The Roxboro Area Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. was chartered Saturday, March 28. It is the first sorority of black

origin to be organized in Roxboro.

In celebration of the occasion, a pre-charter reception was held at the Person County Library on

March 27. City and county officials were present to extend greetings. The Honorable Revis Carver, mayor of Roxboro, Leon Hamlin, president of the

Roxboro Chamber of Commerce; Malcolm Montgomery, chairman of the Person County Board of Commissioners. Approximately 100 persons

attended the reception and fifty attended the Charter Service which was closed to sorority members. Visiting sorority chapters included: Durham Alumnae; NCCU Undergraduate; Chapel Hill-Carrboro Alumnae; UNC-Chapel Hill Undergraduate; High Point Alumnae and Danville, Va. Alumnae.

The keynote speaker for the Pre-Charter reception and Charter Ceremony was Mrs. Norma Sermon, the South-Atlantic Regional Director of Delta Sigma Theta, Inc. Mrs. Sermon was introduced by Mrs. Carolyn Thornton, a member of the Durham Alumnae Chapter — Delta Sigma Theta, Inc., and director of Social Services, Lincoln Mental Health Center.

Mrs. Sermon was presented a key to the city by the mayor and each government official pledged support toward the sorority's Five-Point Program.

### Omegas To Present Talent Hunt Sunday

Twelve area high school students will be competing in the local music talent hunt contest sponsored by Beta Phi Chapter of the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. The program will be held on Sunday, April 12, at 5:30 p.m., in the Hillside High School auditorium. Admission is free.

The local talent hunt contest is one of many being conducted throughout the country by local chapters of the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity. The first place winners of the local contests progress to competition at the district level. For the Durham winner, the district competition will be at the annual meeting of the Sixth District (which comprises North and South Carolina) in Charlotte on May 9. District winners then compete on the national level.
