#### United Negro College Fund Special On WTV Saturday

The three-hour "Lou Rawls Parade of Stars" will air on WTVD-TV, Channel 11, Saturday, April 25 at 8 p.m. The variety show is a fundraising special for the United Negro College Fund and its 41 private, historically black colleges and universities. Among



the "stars" will be Dionne Warwick, Bill Cosby, Sammy Davis, Jr., Tony Bennett, Tony Orlando, Loretta Lynn, Norm Crosby and Sister Sledge.

Hosted by Lou Rawls and his co-hosts Ed McMahon and Natalié Cole from the stage of the Las Vegas Tropicana Hotel, the special will feature some of Las Vegas' top entertainers performing their most popuular hits.

"The 'Parade of Stars' is packed with song, humor and plenty of reasons why UNCF colleges — and their 50,000 students — deserve our help," said Nathan Garrett, local CPA, who is general chairman for the 1981 "Parade of Stars" campaign. "I want to encourage everyone living in

and around Durham to tune in, enjoy the great entertainment, and then to pick up a telephone and call in a pledge.'

This is the second year that Rawls has brought together his special friends for the benefit of the United Negro College Fund. In 1980, the "Parade of Stars" aired in over forty cities across the country, raising more than \$3 million in pledges and contributions for UNCF.

WTVD has contributed its studios and air time for the "Parade of Stars." Live broadcasts from 8 to 11 p.m. will feature up-to-the-minutereports on pledges called in during the special. Celebrities, alumni of UNCF colleges, and representatives from area

businesses and civic organizations will appear in Channel 11's studios to pledge their contributions and support for the College Fund.

A contribution to UNCF from Anheuser-Busch Companies, Inc. has served as seed money for the "Parade of Stars." The grant was used to underwrite production of the Las Vegas portions of the special. Additional funds are being invested by the Budweiser brand of Anheuser-Bush for marketing support, displays and special advertising assistance.

This year, some 50,000 students, many of them financially or educationally disadvantaged, are enrolled in UNCF colleges and universities. Money raised by the

United Negro College Fund and its volunteers helps keep tuitions low and affordable. Over half of the students enrolled at UNCF institutions come from families that earn less than \$9,000 annually. Ninety per cent of these young people must seek some form of finanncial assistance. Were

it not for the UNCF colleges,

many would have no chance for a college education.

Lou Rawls has invested his time and talent to raise funds for UNCF schools, as have local citizens, coordinated by Nathan T. Garrett.
