**GAY MARCH** — A March for Lesbian and Gay Rights is scheduled to be held in downtown Durham Saturday, June 27, to be followed by a rally at Five Points and a picnic.

An ad hoc coalition sponsoring the march arose after the beating of an allegedly gay man at the Litter River near Durham in April. Among the sponsors are members of the Duke Gay Alliance, Triangle Area Lesbian Feminists, Carolina Gay Association, Triangle Area Gay Scientists, N.C. State Gay community and the Metropolitan Community Church.

Spokespersons for the coalition said the march was organized "to demonstrate unity, celebrate the 12th anniversary of the gay rights movement and emphasize the importance of personal freedom."
