Supt. Withdraws Transfer Request

CHAPEL HILL — Dr. Pamela Mayer, superintendent of the Chapel Hill-Carrboro School System, withdrew her recommendation last week to the school board to transfer three school principals.

Dr. Mayer had recommended that Dr. Randy Marshall, principal of Carrboro Elementary School, be transferred to Ephesus School; that W.W. Edmonds, principal

of Culbreth Junior High School, be transferred to Carrboro Elementary School; and, that Mrs. Virginia "Jenny" Kitzmiller, principal of Glenwood Elementary School, be transferred to Frank Porter Graham Elementary.

Approximately 500 parents and teachers had attended the May 18 meeting to protest the decision to recommend the transfers, which Dr. Mayer said, she had made without consultation with board members and staff, because she felt that administrators slated for the transfers could better serve the school system in the recommended positions.

After the lengthy executive session on May 18, before which 32 parents and teachers had asked that the school board deny Dr. Mayer's recommendation, the school board postponed a decision on

the matter until last week's meeting. Meanwhile, parents and teachers continued to voice their opposition in the form of petitions and meetings with the superintendent.

At last week's meeting, the board again held an executive session on the matter and drew a split vote on the recommendation, a vote which some parents say surprised them because it had been rumored that the school board had favored the transfer request.

After the board vote, Dr. Mayer withdrew her recommendation, stating that she will review the

system at the end of the coming school year (1982), and then make recommendations based on that review.

Two administrative vacancies have occurred in the school system due to promotions and retirement, and Dr. Mayer said that she will fill them from outside the system rather than transfer administrators from within the system.

Dr. Mayer assumed the position of superintendent of the Chapel Hill-Carrboro School System in December, 1980, upon the resignation of former superintendent, Dr. Robert Hanes.
