Laura Dean Dancers And Musicians To Perform New Work

A new work by choreographer/composer Laura Dean will highlight her company's appearance at the American Dance Festival July 2-4.

Tympani, commissioned



jointly by the American Dance Festival, the Brooklyn Academy of Music and the Walker Art Center in Minneapolis, was created for six dancers, two pianos and tymponic

Performances are scheduled at 8 p.m. in Duke University's Page Auditorium.

The new work will be performed each evening, with Song on the program Thursday and Friday. Saturday's performance will include Dance.

Since 1974, when the Laura Dean Dancers and Musicians was formed. Dean's works have earned much critical acclaim. Her company and the Pilobolus

Dance Theatre have emerged as the two most prominent dance groups from the '70s,

A New York native, Dean performed with such artists as Paul Taylor before forming her own dance company. All the group's choreography and music are created by Dean, and all dances are performed to live music.

The premiere of Tympani at the Walker Art Center was taped for broadcast and will be seen on public television in August. Immediately after her performances here, Dean will be working at the ADF with director Phil Gay on a piece especially for television, which will be seen at a later date.

The company recently returned from a State Department tour of New Zealand, India and Indonesia, which was a great success. Last winter, Laura Dean participated in the first official cultural exchange between the U. S. and China, touring the country with choreographers Arthur Mitchell and Bella Lewitsky, among others.

Dean's Night, choreographed for the Joffrey Ballet, received wide accalim in the ballet world at its premiere last fall.

Dean's association with the ADF began in 1974 when she premiered Changing as part of the Festival's Emerging Generation series — a program which showcases outstanding work by young choreographers. That program is part of the ADF this

year for the first time since the Festival moved to North Carolina, with performances slated July 7-12 at Stewart Theatre in Raleigh.

This year's Emerging Generation choreographers are Johanna Boyce, Molissa Fenley, Bill & T. Jones, Charles Moulton and Marleen Pennison.

Other ADF performances, all in Duke's Page Auditorium, will be two special programs by the Paul Taylor Dance Company July 12-13, with the July 12 performance a benefit for the company and the ADF; the Chuck Davis Dance Company, July 14; Vaudeville Alive and Dancing, July 16-18; and Pilobus Dance Theatre, July 21-25.
